#### Fontanelle Shuttle

Students who live in the town of Fontanelle should report to the Middle School building by 7:50 a.m. Kindergarten through 5th grade students and high school students will leave for Greenfield at 7:55 a.m.

#### Greenfield Shuttle

Middle school students should be at the high school by 7:50 a.m.. Buses to the middle school will leave at 7:55 A.M sharp in order to get students to the middle school in time for breakfast..

Buses will unload the 6th, 7th and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students at the elementary school at the end of the day.

#### Seat Belts

All regular route buses are now equipped with 3 point seatbelts. School policy states “All three-point lap-shoulder belts available on district buses will be used by passengers when the vehicle is in any non-stationary gear.” Students not wearing seat belts in school vehicles and buses will be subject to the bus write up process outlined in the student handbook.
